



The Norwegian education system




Relevant to this call are:

- Networks within the marine and maritime sector




Contacting potential partners



- Present a (reasonably) clear picture of the project or the activity.
- 2. Your inquiry should be clear, comprehensive, tempting and not too long.
- 3. You should invite the DS partner to be involved in the project development.
- 4. Send your inquiry as early as possible.
- 5. Try to reach out to the right people.
