The Environment Program has strategic goals aimed at promoting the good environmental status of ecosystems and reduce the adverse effects of pollution and other activities

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## Evaluation

Systematic, objective, and independent analysis of the design, implementation, and/or results achieved in programs and projects, with the aim of determining the relevance, coherence and consistency, effectiveness, efficiency, impacts, and sustainability of the financial contribution.



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## Methodology

Plural methodological framework (document analysis, semi-structured interviews, focus group, and case studies). All relevant actors involved in the program's implementation and stakeholders interested in its outcomes were engaged.

## Main Conclusions

Good performance of the indicators (with the exception of three affected by COVID-19 and the war in Ukraine). The program management contributed to mitigating contextual constraints. The absence of an information system for project monitoring and the burden of bureaucratic procedures associated with reporting were the identified constraints.



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## Main Recommendations

The distinguishing features of the Program, particularly the co-financing rate and eligibility criteria, should be maintained as a guarantee of the Program's attractiveness. A support information system for management and monitoring should be developed.
